



# BRISTOL - BRISTOL SYSTEM

## Note:

In corner compositions with pouf/elements width 970/1940 Poliform suggests not to use elements depth 1050.

In this case, there is not alignment among elements. (as in drawing 1).

The following combinations are instead suggested:

- corner/central pouf width 970/1940 with backward pouf depth 640 (as in drawing 2);

- corner/central pouf depth 1050 with elements width 1170/1520.

The lines in the seat of the chaise longue highlight the seams that are in both the fabric and leather versions.

Chaise longue with Persia and Tebe fabrics don't have seams, except for elements 1500 - 1600 that have a central seam.

The trace in the drawing of the elements 1420 - 1520 - 1620 highlights the seams that are only in the leather version and for the Persia and Tebe fabrics.
